**Energy Conservation Program** 

The primary objective is to reduce fuel expenditures for the low-income household. The program conducts furnace efficiency testing where gas or oil is the primary heating source. They clean and fine tune the furnace when efficiency is below 75%. In some cases where efficiency is extremely low, a high efficiency model may be installed. Heating and/or hot water tank repairs or replacements as approved by Housing and Community Renewal (HCR).
